## 6. **ACTION ITEMS / NEW BUSINESS**

### a) **Dominic Losito & Brian Johnston, Drinking Water Officers**

Andrew Mak explained how the City of Vancouver has a Plumbing Inspector doing surveys of existing private building. I then talked about how a sub-committee had been formed by this committee to explore and implement a Survey Specialist classification. The purpose of this class of CCC specialist is to be able to do the backflow surveys of private properties by the private sector. One of the benefits of this approach as opposed to the Water Supplier doing these surveys with their Plumbing Inspectors is that this removes the responsibility of the survey from the Water Supplier and places it on the owner of the property. The added benefit is that there could be a number of surveys done in a relatively short period of time

Brian Johnston mentioned that the next Regional Drinking Water Meeting would be held in Prince George and that a CCC Committee member should attend.

### b) **Tester Re-Certification**

Rick Hayhurst said that it will move forward. Another subcommittee meeting will be held in the near future. Rick Hayhurst to advise committee members of date.
