

ANNUAL CROSS CONNECTION CONTROL CERTIFICATION RENEWAL

2008 RENEWAL

The fee for renewing your Cross-Connection Control Tester Certification for 2008 is \$50.00.

As of January 1996, Certified Cross Connection members will receive renewal notification yearly. There will no longer be a two-year grace period.

Per the BC Plumbing Code, 1998, failure to renew your annual certification by the prescribed due date (expiry date) will result in:

- a) your future tests not being recognized by municipalities, and
- b) having to rewrite the BCWWA testers exam prior to renewal of your certification.

Renewal notices will be mailed at least one month prior to your expiry date. This will give you ample time to respond.

2008 CROSS CONNECTION CONTROL CERTIFICATION RENEWAL

MEMBERSHIP DEFINITIONS:

1) ACTIVE TESTER CERTIFICATION

An "Active" Certified or Re-Certified Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester shall have successfully completed and passed a Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester's Course in Backflow prevention assembly testing at an accredited school or college. Certification through reciprocity with another recognized Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester Certification Program. Proof shall be provided by the Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester to the BCWWA – Cross Connection Control Committee that he/she has tested a minimum of two assemblies of each of the following – RPBA, DCVA, and PVBA within the previous licensed or registered period, or as required by the BCWWA – Cross Connection Control Committee. If a tester fails to maintain his/her "Active" status for a period greater than one year, the BCWWA – Cross Connection Control Committee shall require the individual to pass another examination at an accredited school or college before his/her application for membership is again considered.

2) ADMINISTRATION/INSPECTOR SPECIALIST

(A) Cross-Connection Control Program Manager

This category is suited to the Water Purveyor, who administers a recognized Cross-Connection Control Program for a Water Utility. His/her role as an "Administrator" is clearly one of program management. He/she is not expected to be active in the field, testing assemblies, or in the day-to-day operation of a recognized Cross-Connection Control Program. The Program Manager shall have a "working knowledge" in the operation of a recognized Cross-Connection Control Program.

(B) Cross-Connection Control Inspector/Specialist

The Inspector/Specialist shall report to the Program Manager. He/she is responsible for over seeing the daily operation of a Water Purveyor's Cross-Connection Control Program, which includes the review of mechanical plans submitted for various permit(s), for carrying out ongoing site surveys, inspection of assembly installations, monitoring of the required annual assembly tests, and the keeping of accurate records. Having previously taken a Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester's Course would be a valuable asset to this position.

Under either of the above two "Administration" memberships, the member is not certified to test backflow prevention assemblies. To test assemblies, the "Administrator" must take or have taken and successfully passed the Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester's course and exams from an accredited school or college.

3) ASSOCIATE MEMBER

This category is open for those interested in Cross Connection Control and currently working in Water and/or Wastewater related fields. This includes, but is not limited to the following fields:

Architects, Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester who have allowed their "Certification" to lapse, or who have chosen not to continue testing assemblies (i.e. Retired), Building and Office Managers, Consultants, Educators, Engineers, Fire Sprinkler Fitter, Health and/or Medical Officers, Inspectors, Lawn/Garden Irrigation Installers, Manufacturing and Sales Personnel, Professionals, Refrigeration Installers, Steam Fitters, T.Q. Plumbers, Water Utility Managers, Water Utility Operators, etc.
