This annual three-day conference is the premier water and wastewater event for BC bringing together over 1,000 attendees from across BC, the Yukon and beyond.



VIRTUAL CLASSROOMS, ONLINE COURSES & IN-CLASS OPTIONS

For more than four decades, the BCWWA has been one of the largest and most trusted sources of training in BC and the Yukon, preparing water professionals for certification exams, providing continuing education unit (CEU) credits and helping professionals advance their careers.

Our courses are offered in three different formats: in-class, online and custom training.

INSTRUCTOR-LED CLASSES


WATERMARK MAGAZINE
